

Industry-Wide Research Survey Launched at HLTH

The HealthCare Executive Group, in partnership with Change Healthcare, Launch the 10th Annual Industry Pulse Research Survey

Las Vegas, October 28th, 2019 - The <u>Industry Pulse Research Survey</u>, developed by the <u>HealthCare</u> Executive Group (HCEG) with sponsor partner Change Healthcare, has launched in time for HLTH.



The survey, drafted by a diverse representation of healthcare stakeholders, is a deeper dive into the <u>2020 HCEG Top 10</u> (the annual list of the opportunities, priorities and challenges facing HCEG healthcare executives) as voted and ranked by the HCEG members and sponsor partners during the organization's <u>Annual Forum in September</u>. This marks the 10th year that HCEG has facilitated the networking to develop and execute the national study.

The <u>Industry Pulse Research survey</u> will be live until November 29th, 2019. Executives from across the healthcare ecosystem are asked to participate and help shape the future

of healthcare. Results will be published early in 2020. Survey participants will receive an advance copy of the results report and an invite to a webinar to discuss the findings, which could be a valuable resource to help organizations navigate the complexities of our rapidly evolving healthcare system.
